Mike made a motion to have emergency repairs done to the dangerous-to-drive-over Button Hill bridge: Wayne Hook will replace the existing structure with a temporary culvert for \$16,000. John seconded. So moved.

Discussion about having Jackie send permission form to Jimmie and Laura Lee. Rodney needs landowners' permission to install new culvert on Swayze Rd. that empties into Lee property.

Pike is planning paving project in Tunbridge, from 8/30 through 9/1.

New Business:

Goats: Mike Barnaby, owner of three errant goats that are roaming the Strafford Road, is aware of the problem, and will make a fenced enclosure for them.


Town Hall: Jackie will call Fire Marshall to see if fire escape fix is OK and repairs and painting can proceed.

Adjourned, 8:19 PM.


