Brocklebank Quarry – Rock of Ages was not interested in taking material out as not economically feasible for them to use. EPH, LLC. Or Peter Hayden currently owns the 521 acres around the quarry. The quarry is 5 acres and is valued at \$8400.00 in the grand list. The Town might be interested in use of granite material for roads.

Approved Special Events permit for Brocklebank Brewery for June 10th.

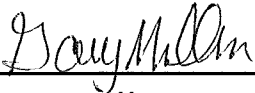
Transfer Station – John made motion to purchase 15 sections of fencing at \$55.00 per section for Transfer Station. Mike Second. So moved.

EC Fiber Board – Bruce Mullen appointed as representative.

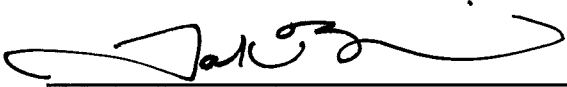
Approved Payroll and Warrants.
