

TUNBRIDGE SELECTBOARD MEETING

February 23, 2021, via ZOOM

Road Report: Larry's truck is in Lebanon getting coolant hose replaced. Otherwise, things are good with the Town garage.

McPhetres made a motion to accept the Tenco of Barre, VT bid of \$40,779 for a truck body, sander, and plow for the new truck. O'Brien seconded, so moved.

Library Trustees: McPhetres made a motion to accept the resignation of Billie Smith affective Feb. 26, 2021 and Fern Strong affective March 31, 2021 as library trustees. O'Brien seconded, so moved. Appreciations for their support of the Tunbridge Library.

O'Brien motioned to appoint Michael Krauthamer to Library trustee affective Feb. 26, 2021, Anita Abbot affective Feb. 28th, and Anna Dechert affective March 31, 2021. McPhetres seconded, so moved.

Transfer station grant possibilities were discussed. Selectboard will look into new gates and replacement to any fencing. Also, it was suggested that a sign board would be a good idea at the transfer station. Quotes will be sought before grant is applied for.

Online transfer station will be live in mid-March. This is another option along with purchasing them at the library. Maguire demonstrated to the Selectboard how tickets would be purchase on the Town website with a credit card. Announcements will be made when it is ready for public access. The Selectedboard voted to approve this.

Warrants as of Feb. 22, were approved. McPhetres motioned, O'Brien seconded, so moved.
