


- 3. Bicycle use would interfere with traditional agricultural use of pasture.
 - Bicycles can make cows panic and run and get lost.
 - Bicycle activity would conflict with efforts to keep cows out of stream to comply with VT Clean Water Act.
- 4. Opening Baptist Hill Trail to bicycles would add little to Tunbridge bicycle route system.
- 5. Baptist Hill Trail should be retained as a public right of way and designated for pedestrian use.
