Mike made motion to have Janet Zug purchase #11 toppers for railing at Town Hall. John second. So moved.


John will speak with Bert in regards to violations at the Transfer Station.

Jackie to send letter to Blakeman Towing stating that no permit for junkyard will be approved until all issues with the State of Vermont have been resolved.


Mike made motion to approve bill for Randolph Plumbing and Heating for work done at Town Office Building.
