

**Trustee of Public Funds**  
**June 15, 2018**

The Trustees of Public Funds met on June 15, 2018 at the Town Office Building. All Trustees were present (Matt Frost, Jonni Spaulding, Rob Howe). The meeting was legally warned and individuals in town were notified about the meeting in order to meet any requests for distributing funds.

Jonni shared that she had attended the select board meeting during the week prior and had brought the request forms from them for special projects. They requested \$1000 for a new fence at the transfer station, \$2500 to improve the bathroom at the town garage, and \$500 for the restoration of a curtain for the town hall. This request was approved and the funds will come out of the Special Projects Fund.

Elaine Howe was present to request \$3000 for the School Library, coming from Edith Grant Funds. Approved

Baxter Doty attended for the Cemetery Commissioners. He brought the request for \$7000 for maintenance and upkeep, which was part of the budget approved at Town Meeting. The Trustees agreed to take \$5000 from the Cemetery account, and \$2000 from the Village Cemetery Funds to cover this request. Baxter reported that some plots had been sold during the past year and the funds raised had been used for the perpetual care of cemeteries, rather than being invested. The Trustees questioned this decision, thinking that this would be a way to increase the principal in that account.

The next scheduled meeting will be Sept. 28.
