

## Echeverria Notes on the Baptist Hill Trail

1. No record of past bicycle use/minimal past use for walking.
2. Significant part of trail is old sunken road, badly situated next to a perennial stream and generally quite muddy.
3. Possible reconstruction might create new water quality problems.
4. Bicycle use would interfere with traditional agricultural use.
5. Trail would add little to Tunbridge bicycle route system.
6. Opening trail to bicycle use would allow bicycles to pass through front yard of Dodge Farm farmhouse

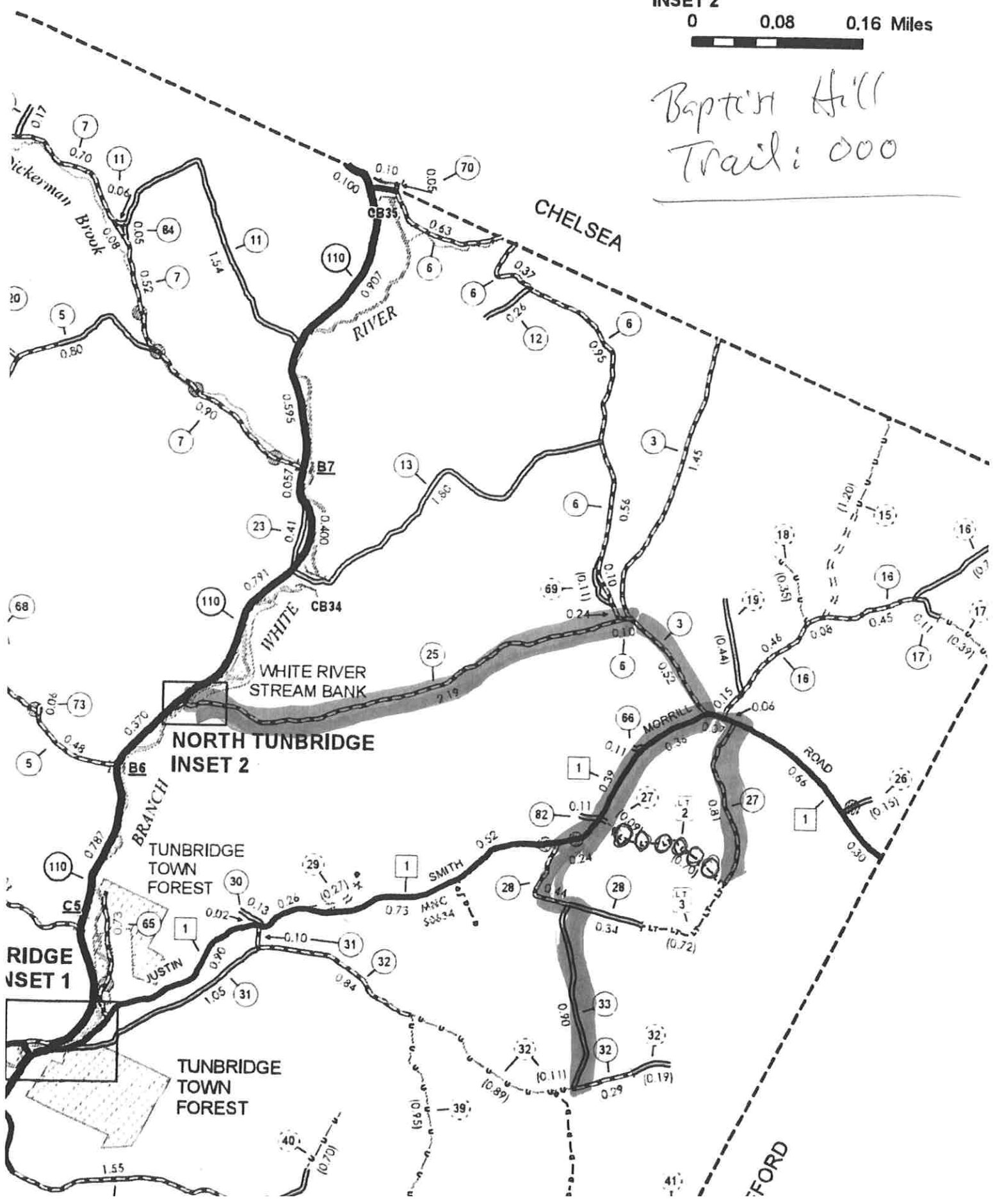




NORTH TUNBRIDGE SCALE 1:6,336
