Trails Committee

The trails committee was appointed by the Tunbridge selectboard with recommendations for members from the Planning Commission to further study the 4 legal trails (2.45 miles in total) in town. These trails are declassified from class 4 roads and have not been maintained by the town for decades.

Each trail is unique - there has been some minimal use as logging roads or for agricultural access. They have recently been walking paths primarily but were mostly forgotten and unused through many decades.

The main issue is whether the legal trails should be upgraded for mixed use by hikers, equestrians, bicycles and e-bikes along with what that means for the town and landowners going forward?

Or should the legal trails remain as primitive trails for walking only and what that means for the town and landowners going forward?

What questions would you like the trails committee to address?
