

# **Town Plan Public Hearing Notice**

## **Town of Tunbridge**

The Selectboard of the Town of Tunbridge will hold a hearing on the proposed revisions to the Tunbridge Town Plan on December 14, 2021, at 5:30 pm at the Tunbridge Town Office (271 VT RTE 110). The Selectboard invites comments from residents, landowners, neighboring towns, the regional planning commission, and the State at this public hearing or by mail to PO Box 6, Tunbridge, VT 05077 by the hearing date. The Planning Commission worked on these revisions in 2019 and 2020, and the Selectboard is now ready to adopt them. The Town Plan contains background information on the Town, and is a statement of policies and a list of recommendations for the future that are meant to ensure stable public services, encourage health and prosperity, protect natural resources, guide land use, and help bring about a desired future vision.

The proposal covers all lands within the Town of Tunbridge. Full copies of the draft Town Plan and maps are available for review at the Tunbridge Town Offices and on the Town website. Below is a summary of the proposal.
