

TRANSFER STATION POLICY

To better serve our townspeople, the following policy regarding items and quantities are hereby put in place.

The Town of Tunbridge would like to encourage its residents to deliver a consistent stream of transfer station items instead of a "spring cleaning" type of delivery. This helps ensure proper container space for all the residents to be able to unload their items each week.

Transfer Station is for Residential Use: Commercial Use Not Encouraged

Items Accepted at this location:

Please familiarize yourself with all acceptable and unacceptable materials listed below prior to visiting this location.

Trash (such as household waste) \$1.00 for bathroom size bags, \$2.00 for kitchen size bags, \$3.00 for contractor size bags

Recycling (such as cardboard, paper, plastics, metal cans, and glass) Free

Yard Waste (such as brush, leaves, and lawn clippings) Free

Food Scraps (such as fruits, vegetables, meats, dairy, oils, coffee and prepared foods) Free

Bulky Items (such as furniture, appliances, and mattresses) \$10.00 per item

Tires Car Tires \$2.00 each, Truck/Tractor Tires \$10.00 each

Items NOT accepted at this location:

We suggest using ARCC in Barre or Bethel Royalton Transfer station for the following items. If you have a material that is not accepted at this location please find another location, or for more information, contact the Town of Tunbridge.

Hazardous Waste (such as chemicals, paint and cleaning fluids)

Universal Waste (such as batteries, ballasts and light bulbs)

Electronic Waste (such as TV's, monitors, computers, printers, stereos)

Construction & Demolition Debris (such as drywall, metal, shingles, carpet, clean wood & concrete)

Once a year we host a collection date for hazardous waste materials listed above.

This policy is subject to revision pending Central Vermont Solid Waste Management District guidelines and state statutes.
