Good morning Ms. Anderson,

I am writing as Chair of the Planning Commission of the Town of Tunbridge regarding the Advance Notice that was filed by Vertex for a cell tower.

This Advance Notice, 25-0672-AN, was filed by Vertex April 10, 2025. As of this Friday, October 10th, the 6 month deadline to file a Petition for the Certificate of Public Good has come and gone without the Petition being filed. I believe that this means that Advance Notice 25-0672-AN is now defunct and that a new Advance Notice would need to be filed by Vertex in order to start the process anew.

I'm writing to request that this Advance Notice be removed from the PUC site as it is no longer valid.
