Transfer Station Bag/Barrel Limit Policy**

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to prevent overloading of the compactors, maintain safe and efficient operations, and ensure fair use of the Tunbridge Transfer Station by all eligible users. Limiting the amount of waste per visit helps manage equipment capacity and reduces the risk of mechanical failure or unsafe conditions.

2. Bag/Barrel Limit

Each household is limited to a maximum of:

Eight (8) bags or barrels per visit, up to 55 gallons each

For the purposes of this policy:

- A “bag” includes any trash bag **up to 55 gallons**.
 - A “barrel” includes any rigid container **up to 55 gallons**.
 - Oversized bags, contractor bags larger than 55 gallons, or barrels exceeding 55 gallons may be refused or charged separately under the Town’s Fee & Ticket Policy.

3. Enforcement

Transfer Station staff are authorized to:

- Count bags or barrels presented for disposal
- Deny disposal of waste exceeding the eight-unit limit
- Request that users return on another day with excess waste
- Report repeated violations to the Selectboard

Staff may also direct users to distribute waste appropriately between compactors to avoid overloading.

The foregoing Policy is hereby adopted by the Selectboard of the Town of Tunbridge, Vermont the 10th day of March 2026 and is effective as of this date until amended or repealed.
