

Strawberry Hill Trail

TRAIL OVERVIEW

Welcome to Strawberry Hill. This public path is established via a perpetual easement for the community to enjoy the natural beauty of Tunbridge.

- **Access:** The trail begins at Morrill Road and travels generally westward.
- **The Path:** The trail follows a designated strip approximately 5 feet in width.
- **The Destination:** The path leads to the peak of Strawberry Hill, featuring a 1,000-square-foot viewing site.

VISITOR RULES & HOURS

To ensure the trail remains a shared resource, please observe the following requirements:

- **Hours:** The trail is open from dawn to dusk only.
- **Pedestrian Only:** This path is for pedestrian use only.
- **No Motorized Vehicles:** ATVs and snowmobiles are strictly prohibited (except for landowner use).
- **Commercial Vehicles:** No commercial trucks or buses are permitted to park in the easement area.

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

- **Pack It In, Pack It Out:** No trash barrels or dumpsters are provided. The disposal of trash or refuse on the land is prohibited.
- **Summit Amenities:** A public bench seat is maintained at the peak for your convenience.
- **Fencing & Livestock:** Please respect the circular fencing at the summit; it is maintained to keep the viewing area free of cow manure. No additional fencing may be placed in the area.
- **No Construction:** No buildings or structures may be placed on the easement area.

***Trail Maintenance:** This path is accessible year-round and is maintained by the Town of Tunbridge through the Tunbridge Trails Committee.*
